is best for YOUR Needs?**

**“Ihler Turf”**- Our premium turf mix is a customer favorite and one we have used since 1994. Our premium turf mixes have the highest quality varieties of Kentucky Bluegrass and Perennial Rye in them. These varieties have performed the best in industry tests for our intermountain climate. Our varieties create the dark green color you expect, as well as an assured hardy and disease resistant stand of grass. Planting rate 6.25 lbs/1000'. **Our personal favorite!**



**Premium Turf Mix**- Mixture of Kentucky Blue varieties, perennial rye and creeping red fescue. People like it most because it gets that darker green color and soft with added durability for traffic and is disease resistant. Planting rate 6.25 lbs/1000'.

**Cache Valley Blend** is very close to the premium blend. It is just more fit for cooler temps and higher elevation. It has Kentucky Blue varieties, perennial rye, and creeping red fescue. Planting rate 6.25 lbs/1000'.



**Cabin Mix** Dryland Turf. The best choice for alternative turf in the Intermountain West. Sheep Fescue; Roadcrest, crested wheatgrass; Sodas, streambank wheatgrass. These three grasses are very deep rooted and can survive years of drought. They are naturally a green color fall through spring. If they are watered and mowed once or twice a month, they will stay green in the summer as well giving a nice manicured lawn look. If left without water or mowing it will grow about 18" tall and will go dormant and brown in hot summer months. 3 lbs/1000'.

**Elite Kentucky Blue Blend** Only has KBG varieties. This is the choice for people that just want that gorgeous softest darkest color. (The downside is it needs a lot more water and if you have high traffic areas it may die out in those areas.) Planting rate 6.25 lbs/1000'.

**Athletic Blend Turf** Tall fescue, perennial ryegrass and KBG. This is a coarser turf, but very traffic resistant. It is mostly used for athletic turf for fields, or homes that have many animals that are rough on the yard. Planting rate 16 lbs/1000'.



**Dryland Pasture Mix** Crested Wheatgrass, smooth brome, slender wheatgrass, orchard grass, intermediate wheatgrass. Alfalfa and small burnet. You would want to use this in places you would like to graze animals on. Mostly cattle but some sheep and goats can work too. Does not need water other than rainfall, but if there is a true dry period it would be good to water once a month if no rainfall occurs. Planting rate 33 lbs/acre.

**Irrigated Pasture Mix**- Meadow brome, orchard grass, perennial ryegrass, tall fescue. Needs to be irrigated. It is better for small mouthed animals due to its more grassy nature. Planting rate 44 lbs/acre.



**Wildflower Mixes** We keep two kinds in stock. Rocky Mountain Wildflower mix for higher elevation, spring to fall blooms, needs mild irrigation. Dryland Wildflower mix can live with just rainfall from Mother Nature. Both mixes have over 20 varieties and colors in each. Planting rates = Light 1/2 lb/1000'...Heavy 2.0 lbs/1000'.
